I'm proud to share that after ten incredible years, San Antonio Pets Alive! (SAPA!) continues to be a lifesaving leader in our city - taking in the animals often overlooked by other rescue groups and adopters. SAPA! **always has and always will** strive to give them the chance of a happy and healthy life.

As we continue to face uncertainty and hardships due to COVID-19, our lifesaving efforts keep going full speed ahead, **saving 4,745** at-risk cats and dogs in 2021. Vulnerable puppies, dogs, kittens, and cats need us, and we need them to comfort and befriend us. Every time I witness a happy tails story, my heart is whole, knowing these animals endured great obstacles and are now thriving with their new families.

2021 Highlights

- Honored our commitment to the community to spay and neuter all of our animals prior to being adopted.
- Re-launched our transport and volunteer programs which were halted in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Participated in two BISSELL Foundation Empty the Shelters events resulting in 231 adoptions.
- Received two multi-year grants, helping to provide financial stability.
- Grew our board with the addition of three new directors who are deeply committed to our lifesaving mission.
- Enhanced our rescue transfer application process, improving our protocols and evaluations of our rescue partners.
- Worked with more than 1,000 fosters who loved and cared for our animals.
- Saved more than 600 cats ang dogs through our Public Intake Program, a 67% increase.

Thank you for helping to make these achievements possible and for believing, as we do, that saving animals is an important priority in our community. There is still much work to be done, but the future is bright with you by our side.



TRANSPORT

SAPA! Transported 114 Animals in 2021

We relaunched our Headin' Home transport program after the program was halted due to COVID-19. Our transports were made possible by generous donors, animal rescue partners, and fosters. Our Headin' Home program transports dogs to rescue partners in other states with available space.

These dogs are adopted out quickly in their new state instead of staying in our facilities or foster homes, allowing San Antonio Pets Alive! to save more lives!









PLACEMENT

SAPA! collaborates with animal welfare organizations across the country and internationally to save as many lives as possible. We partner with more than **110** animal welfare organizations in 25 states and Canada. In 2021, SAPA!'s placement team established 27 new partnerships, and **1,424** of our animals were transferred to other partners, a 53% increase over 2020.



Rescue Partner Highlight

A special thank you to Hope for Love Rescue, one of our largest rescue partners. Hope for Love Rescue helped our lifesaving efforts by pulling 77 dogs into their care last year. They always have a foster lined up for each dog they pull and are a pleasure to work with!

FOSTER SUCCESS STORY



Sweet Gabby and her six tiny puppies (Graham, Gilbert, Gigi, Ginger, Guiseppe, and Griffin) were found as strays this past October. SAPA! and our amazing fosters swooped in to save them from an uncertain future. All had an awful upper respiratory infection and were barely strong enough to survive. With treatment, love, and care from our Medical Care Center team and fosters, they fought through their illnesses and survived. They have all found wonderful homes, including miss Gabby! How could anyone resist these precious faces? We are thrilled that this whole family can get the chance to know what love is.

Melissa Christman

Melissa and David have fostered five momma dogs and their 36 puppies with some mothers giving birth while in their care. They will also take in a single puppy and kitten that need a foster. The Christmans take excellent care of their fosters and find wonderful loving homes for them. Melissa also serves as a mentor for fosters that foster moms and pups. Since 2018, this dynamic duo has cared for 257 of our dogs, puppies, and kittens!



Valri Berkoff

Valri has been fostering for SAPA! for many years. She is patient, takes excellent care of her fosters, and finds them loving families. Every time we ask Valri to foster a kitten that needs an urgent placement, she says, "yes." She also helps other fosters when they need to transfer their kittens. Valri fostered 53 kittens in 2021 and a total of 228 kittens, cats, and dogs since she started fostering in 2018.

HAPPY TAILS STORIES

Homer

Homer, a three-year-old Malinois Belgian mix, came into our care from the City of San Antonio Animal Care Services. After a few days, Homer was pre-adopted in September 2021 by a family who instantly fell in love with him.

Sadly, Homer had to complete several medical treatments before going home with his forever family. While waiting to go to his new home, his family visited him daily.

Our Lifesaving team loved to watch the bond between Homer and his forever family bloom and flourish. Homer waited for his family to visit and had his ball in his mouth, ready to play fetch with his soon-to-be human brother. He received a ton of cuddles and support from his family as he recovered from his illnesses.

We are happy to share that Homer loves his new life and is best buds with his human brother!







Mason

Mason is a sweet seven-month-old kitten that was brought into our care from San Antonio Animal Care Services. Our medical team administered several tests, and little Mason tested positive for Feline Leukemia (a virus that affects a cat's immune system). We were able to get Mason the treatment he needed to live a normal life with appropriate care.

In addition to Feline Leukemia, Mason contracted Pan Leukopenia virus as a stray kitten and needed round-the-clock specialized care to beat it. Pan Leukopenia acts very much like the Parvo and Distemper viruses in puppies and was once a leading cause of death in stray cats.

This curious kitty loves attention almost as much as he loves cuddles. He is a huge cuddle bug who adores being petted, carried and held. He is very capable of entertaining himself all day with a simple toy. He is a quirky, vocal, curious, and loving companion.

Mason's foster couldn't let him go, and he is now an official member of their family.

VOLUNTEERS


