



# **SAPA! Foster Vaccine Schedule**

## **Routine Medical Care for Dogs**

SAPA! vaccinates for DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus), BORDETELLA (vaccinates against the most common form of Kennel Cough) and Rabies. In addition, all dogs receive flea/tick (Frontline) and heartworm (Ivermectin) prevention. Dogs and puppies are dewormed. \*Rabies is not given until 12 weeks and only by a licensed vet.

After the first 5 months (20 wks.) of age, your foster dog will require the following regular preventatives and vaccinations:

Frontline (flea/tick): MonthlyRabies: Every 1 YearIvermectin (heartworm): MonthlyDHPP: Every 1 YearBORDETELLA: Every 6 monthsStrongid: Monthly

**Note:** Adult dogs receive the following upon intake (unless we have documentation that they have already received these): Strongid (dewormer), DHPP, flea treatment, BORDETELLA, and rabies.

The SAPA! medical team provides all medical care to our foster dogs. SAPA! WILL NOT reimburse foster parents for any medical expenses incurred without pre-approval by the SAPA! Medical Clinic.

### **Routine Medical Care for Cats**

SAPA! vaccinates for FVRCP (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia) and Rabies. In addition, all cats receive flea/tick preventative). Cats and kittens are dewormed. \*Rabies is not given until 12 weeks and only by a licensed vet.

After the first 5 months (20 wks.) of age, your foster cat will require the following regular preventatives and vaccinations:

**Frontline**(flea/tick): Monthly **Rabies**: Every 1 Year **Strongid**: Monthly

**FeLV Test:** Every 1 Year

**Note:** Adult cats receive the following upon intake (unless we have documentation that they have already received these): Strongid (dewormer), FVRCP, flea treatment, and rabies. Two weeks later they receive their second Strongid and FVRCP. In most cases, the FeLV test and microchip are included with the spay/neuter surgery.

The SAPA! medical team provides all medical care to our foster cats. SAPA! WILL NOT reimburse foster parents for any medical expenses incurred without pre-approval by the SAPA! Medical Clinic.
