San Antonio Pets Alive! Hosts Weekend-Long Adoption Event
Event Aimed to Encourage the Community to Adopt Harvey Rescues

San Antonio TX- San Antonio Pets Alive! will be hosting a weekend-long adoption event beginning on Friday October 13th, and lasting through Sunday, October 15th. The exciting event will take place at the PetSmart Charities® Everyday Adoption Center in the Windsor Park PetSmart, located at [8520 Fourwinds Drive](#) and open from 10 A.M.- 6 P.M. In addition to animals from San Antonio, the adoption event will feature cats and dogs rescued from Harvey-affected areas.

San Antonio Pets Alive! has rescued 280 cats and dogs from the Texas Coastal Bend in addition to their routine intake from the San Antonio city shelter. SAPA! needs the community to adopt and give loving forever homes to these cats and dogs who have been through so much. Every adoption includes spay/ neuter surgery, vaccinations, and a microchip along with 30 days of health insurance. Adoption saves 2 lives through SAPA!'s innovative *Never an Empty Kennel* model. The space freed by each adoption will allow SAPA! to save another animal facing euthanasia here in San Antonio or in an area affected by the storm.

SAPA! will have a variety of cats, kitten, dogs, and puppies for adoption. The *Tail Waggin'*, SAPA!'s 26-foot adoption vehicle sponsored by PetSmart Charities®, will be offering adoptions in the store's parking lot on both Friday and Sunday 11 A.M.-4 P.M. Director of Operations, Clare Callison, says "The outpouring of support from our community has shown us that people care about helping animals affected by Harvey. While there are many ways to help, adopting an animal is a great way to affect a positive change following this natural disaster. When you choose to add to your family through adoption from SAPA!, you are saving not only the pet you take home, but also the life of the cat or dog who will occupy the newly empty kennel."
